



The Koorana Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into three sections and provides families the opportunity to calculate and plan for all costs that they may incur throughout the 2023 school year.

### VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions for 2023: **\$60.00 per child (Years K-6). For families with more than one child, the cost will be scaled at \$50.00 per child for two children and \$40.00 per child for three or more children.**

Contributions collected will be used to supplement school expenditure across the Learning Areas and for Resource Materials adding value to your child’s learning experience. Whilst contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised if all families support this initiative. We fully understand that this may be difficult for some families and any amount you can manage towards contributions is appreciated. Contributions can be paid by instalments, for example \$15.00 per term to assist with family budgeting.

Contributions can be paid through your personal items list to Campion or by Cash, EFTPOS and Direct Deposit to the school. Bank details for direct deposit are: Koorana Primary School: BSB No: 016 441 Account No: 3408 97774.

This charge has been endorsed by the School Board and meets maximum set (\$60.00 per child) in the School Education Regulations 2000.

### SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

The Koorana Primary School Board has approved the following breakdown of estimated **maximum charges** for student’s participation in incursions, excursions, in term swimming, etc – by way of Section 100 of the School Education Act. Detail on charges collected in previous years has formed our 2023 charges schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the Schedule represent the maximum charged for all scheduled activities in 2023. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

**PERSONAL ITEMS** (refers to student personal items (booklist) proposed under Section 108 of the School Education Act)

The charge for personal use items will vary from student to student and includes:

Student requirements for all students and used in lessons.	e.g. stationery items as per K, PP and Yrs 1-6 requirement lists.
Student requirements recommended but not essential for all students.	e.g. art shirt or other pay as you order or use.
Student requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program.	e.g. Leavers shirt, class photographs or other pay as you order or use.

We have negotiated competitive prices for the materials on Student Requirement lists but you are not obliged to use our supplier. Parents are reminded that students will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.

Actual year level lists will be distributed to students that will also detail pick up dates and times for January 2023.

### **WORKBOOKS LEVY**

This year we have added a new Levy to the Personal Items List. It is to assist the school in purchasing two Prime Maths workbooks and the Spelling Mastery workbook. Students use these workbooks in class, working through a different level each year. The workbooks will be sent home when completed. The total cost to the school for these three workbooks is approx. \$60 per child every year. We are asking for \$15 per student from families to support this considerable expense to the school. This levy can be paid on the personal items list or direct to the school through the front office or by Direct Deposit into the school bank account.
